One House Two Looks

This house is an example of a monochromatic look. The colours used are light and dark tones of the same colour family, in this case a more neutral brown.

Colours used are:

- Main Colour: *Lenox Tan* (HC-44)
- Dark Accent: *Middlebury Brown* (HC-68)
- Trim: *Muslin* (OC-12)



This house is an example of a more dramatic, contrasting look. The colours used are complementary red and green, with a creamy off white trim to make a clean accent.

Colours used are:

- Main Colour: *Georgian Brick* (HC-50)
- Contrasting Colour: *Sussex Green* (HC-109)
- Trim: *Acadia White* (OC-38)
